Carmouche Praises Presidents Decision to Lift Offshore Drilling Ban

Carmouche Supports More Domestic Oil and Gas Exploration to Lower Gas Prices

Shreveport, LA – The decision by President Bush to lift an executive ban on offshore drilling was met with enthusiastic support by District Attorney Paul Carmouche, Democratic Congressional Candidate in Louisiana's 4th District.
